ReStore Updates

Since last month, Habitat's Middletown ReStore has benefitted from 321 hours of volunteer support. This is significant volunteer hours for a smaller store like Middletown. The ReStore has completely redesigned its sales floor and warehouse layout. Metal racking was moved from the sales floor to the warehouse. We also eliminated a few item categories. From now on, toilets, sinks, used kitchen cabinets, doors, and windows will all be accepted at the Middletown ReStore but shipped to the Prices Corner ReStore to be sold.
