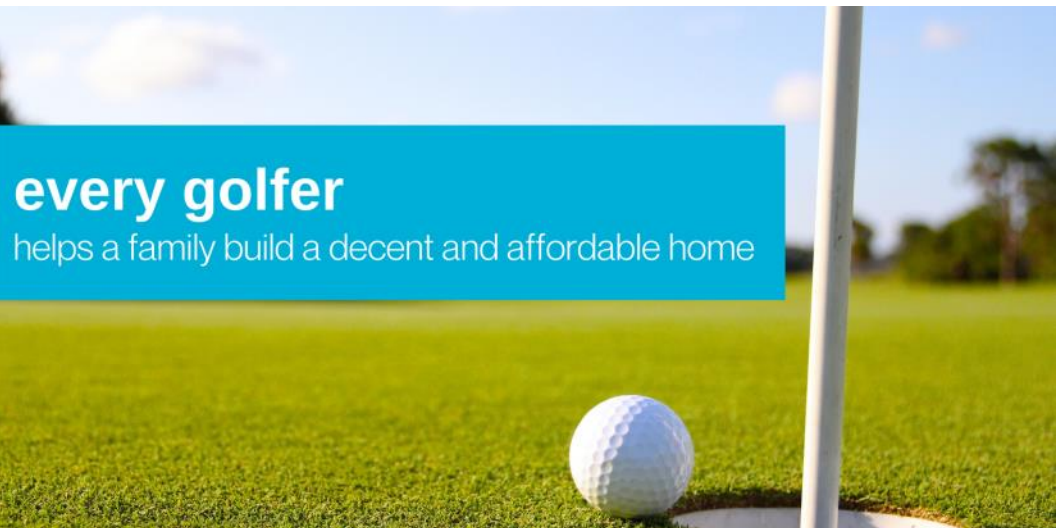

rules

1. We will be playing a Captain's Choice Scramble format. All players will strike their tee shot and your team will choose the best shot. Each player drops their ball at the site of the chosen shot, then strike their second shot from that point and so on, until the ball is holed out. If your team is a threesome, please alternate your fourth shot amongst all the players.
2. Each team member is responsible for at least two (2) tee shots during your round. Please keep track of the drives used on your scorecard so you don't lose track towards the end of your round.
3. Your **Super Ticket** includes two Mulligans. They can be used throughout the day on all your tee shots or longer shots, with the exception of shots on prize holes or shots like closest to the pin, longest drive, or hole-in-one. No mulligans can be used for putting.
4. Your **Super Ticket** includes rolling the dice on **Hole #7** to determine tee location. Subsequent rolls cost \$20 each to get into eagle and birdie range!

There will be an optional pay-to-play game on hole #12 with an air cannon for \$20 per player or \$60 per team. Each player who pays gets to shoot the air cannon for themselves or their team. The player who lands closest to the flag by the end of day wins a **\$50 Gift Card**. If the whole team participates, then your 2nd shot is an 8' foot Eagle Putt.

REDLINING: The practice of refusing to offer credit or insurance in a particular community on a discriminatory basis (as because of the race or ethnicity of its residents)

Throughout the history of the U.S., housing and land policies were deliberately constructed to deny Black households access to homeownership. This discrimination created profound disadvantages for Black families and communities, with lasting effects on educational and economic opportunities for later generations.
